(A PHILLIPS HEAD SCREWDRIVER AND A FLAT-HEAD SCREWDRIVER IS REQUIRED)

DO NOT substitute parts. Contact 1-800-TEL-CRIB for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed.

CRIB ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: To assemble the two Side Frames to the Front and Back Frames, use eight 2 3/4" Bolts, eight washers and the Allen Wrench. Note the notched area of the upper end rail of the End Frame must be attached to the front of the crib. (See Photo)



Step 2: To attach the Mattress Support (Spring) to the crib, decide which position you desire to mount the Mattress Support (Spring). Insert four 3/4" Bolts and four washers through the holes in the arms and into the inserts located in the Front and Back Frames. Tighten using the Allen Wrench.

Once a crib has been converted to a youth bed or adult bed it is not intended to be converted back to a crib.

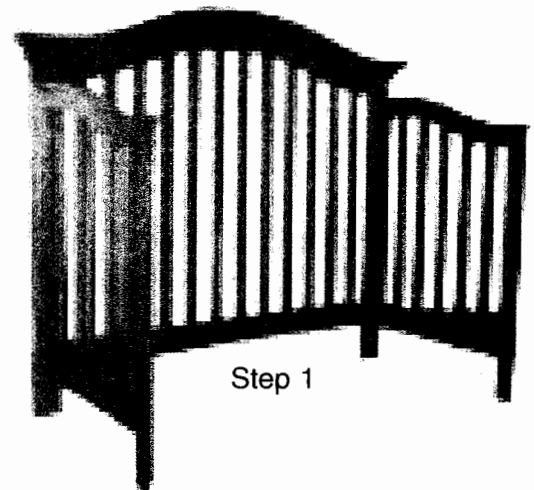
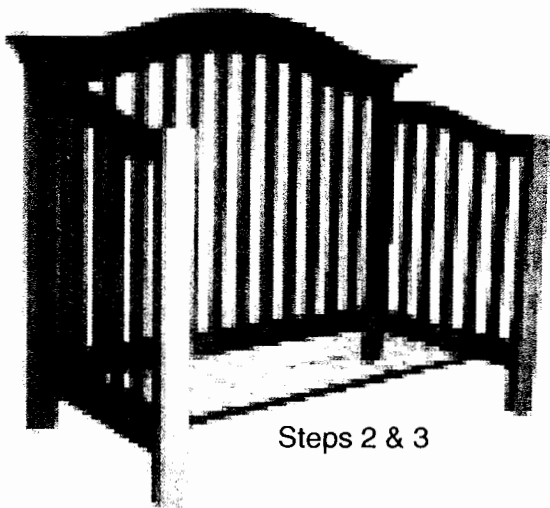
YOUTH BED CONVERSION INSTRUCTIONS

Make sure the Mattress Support (Spring) is in the lowest position for the Youth Bed Conversion stage.

WITHOUT GUARD RAIL

Step 1: Remove the Front Frame from the Crib by removing the four 2 3/4" Bolts. Detach the Mattress Support (Spring) from the Crib.

Step 2: Now attach the two Front Posts to the Side Frame by using the four 2 3/4" Bolts.



Step 3: Attach the Mattress Support (Spring) on each corner by using four 3/4" Bolts and the Allen Wrench, Insert the 3/4" Bolts through holes in the spring arms and into the inserts located in the Front Frame and Front Posts. Tighten using the Allen Wrench.

Once a crib has been converted to a youth bed or adult bed it is not intended to be converted back to a crib.

YOUTH BED CONVERSION INSTRUCTIONS Cont.

Make sure the Mattress Support (Spring) is in the lowest position for the Youth Bed Conversion stage.

Step 4: Tap the 2 Wooden Dowels at each end of the Youth Rail. Attach the Youth Rail to the Front Posts, using two 2 3/4" Bolts and Allen Wrench.



(with Guard Rail)

WITH GUARD RAIL (sold separately)

Follow Steps 1-4 above, but substitute the Youth Rail with the Guard Rail.

Attach the Guard Rail to the Front Posts. Using three 2 3/4" Bolts, and Allen Wrench.

ADULT BED CONVERSION INSTRUCTIONS

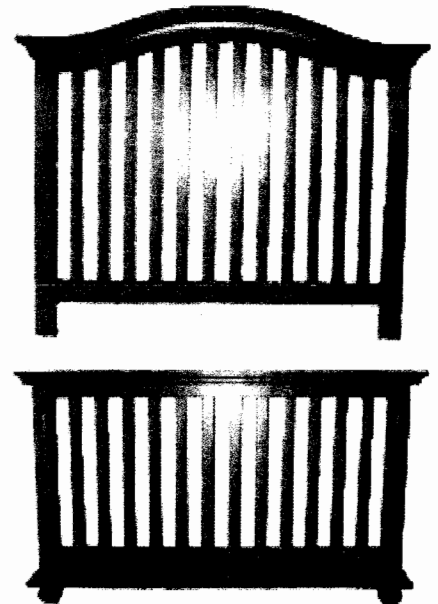
Conversion from crib using Wood Rails (sold separately).

Step 1: To convert to an adult full size bed from a crib you must remove Mattress Support (Spring) and the two Side Frames

Step 2: The Back Frame and the Front Frame of the Crib are the headboard and footboard for the Adult Bed.

Step 3: Find the Adult Rails and hardware included in the Adult Rail Conversion Kit. To attach the Adult Rails to the headboard and footboard, use eight 3/4" Bolts and the Allen Wrench.

Note that the cleats should be at the bottom. (See photo)



Step 4: Attach the five cross slats to the Adult Rails, you will need ten 1" screws and your Phillips Head screwdriver.

The adult bed is not intended to be used by children under 6 years of age without proper adult supervision. This adult bed is NOT a toy. DO NOT allow children to play or climb on adult bed.

CRIB ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

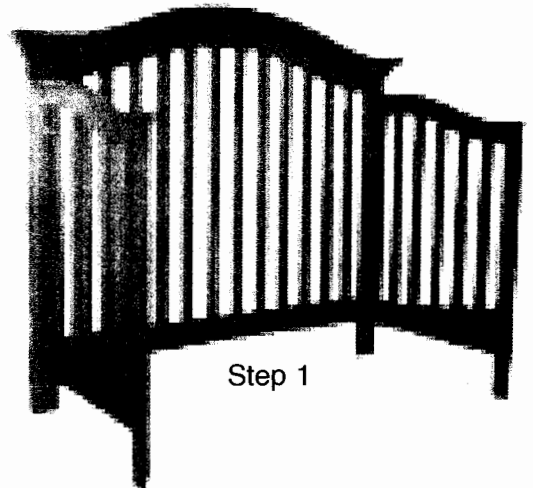

WITHOUT GUARD RAIL

Step 1: Remove the Front Frame from the Crib by removing the four 2 3/4" Bolts. Detach the Mattress Support (Spring) from the Crib.

Step 2: Now attach the two Front Posts to the Side Frame by using the four 2 3/4" Bolts.



Step 3: Attach the Mattress Support (Spring) on each corner by using four 3/4" Bolts and the Allen Wrench, Insert the 3/4" Bolts through holes in the spring arms and into the inserts located in the Front Frame and Front Posts. Tighten using the Allen Wrench.

FOR FUTURE USE AND REFERENCE
RETAIN THIS INSTRUCTION SHEET AND THE CRIB TOOLS IN THE ORIGINAL SACK
AND SECURE IT TO THE SPRING UNDER THE MATTRESS WITH PLASTIC TIES.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS: The natural warmth of wood is a lasting value. Character marks, checking and grain variations are part of the beauty of wood and, therefore, should not be a concern. To preserve your furniture, we suggest the following:

- Do not expose furniture to direct sunlight or extreme changes in temperature or moisture.
- Do not place the furniture near heating or air conditioning vents.
- Wipe up spills promptly.
- When cleaning your furniture, use non-toxic, non-abrasive furniture cleaner with soft, lint-free cloth. Dry thoroughly and then apply furniture polish. Always wipe the furniture in the direction of the wood grain.
- If refinishing, use non-toxic finish specified for children's products.

We recommend the furniture to be polished every six months. Over polishing can distort the natural finish of the product.

WARNING!

✓ Failure to follow these warnings and the assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death.

✓ Infants can suffocate on soft bedding. Never add a pillow or comforter. Never place

additional padding under an infant.

✓ To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.

WARNING!

✓ Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier-cords. Do not suspend strings over a crib or attach strings to toys.

✓ To help prevent strangulation tighten all fasteners. A child can trap parts of the body or clothing on loose fasteners.

✓ DO NOT place crib near window where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.

✓ When child is able to pull to a standing position, set mattress to lowest position and remove bumper pads, large toys and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.

✓ Stop using crib when child begins to climb out or reaches the height of 35 in. (89 cm).

✓ After raising side, make sure latches are secure (omit for stationary side cribs).

✓ DO NOT leave child in crib with side lowered. Be sure side is in raised and locked position whenever child is in crib (omit for stationary side cribs).

✓ Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, loose bolts or other fasteners, missing parts, or sharp edges before and after assembly and frequently during use. Securely tighten loose bolts and other fasteners. DO NOT use crib if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact Baby's Dream Furniture Inc., for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts.

✓ Read all instructions before assembling crib. Keep instructions for future use.

✓ Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers because they can cause suffocation.

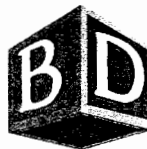
✓ Infants can suffocate in gaps between crib sides and a mattress that is too small.

✓ If refinishing, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.

✓ Follow warnings on all products in a crib.

CAUTION ANY MATTRESS USED IN THIS CRIB MUST BE AT LEAST 27 1/4" X 51 5/8" WITH A THICKNESS NOT EXCEEDING 6". INFANTS CAN SUFFACATE IN GAPS BETWEEN CRIB SIDES AND MATTRESSES THAT ARE TOO SMALL.
