



Double Dresser & Hutch Attachment Instruction Sheet

Read All Instructions Before Assembling. Keep Instructions For Future Use.

- Step 1:** Put the double dresser in the general location that it will be placed.
- Step 2:** Slide the double dresser away from the wall. (Just enough that you can work Behind it.)
- Step 3:** Remove the hutch from the box and apply the felt dots to the bottom edge of the end panel. This will help protect the double dresser top from getting scratched. Use caution when you sit the hutch on top of the double dresser. Center it from left to right.
- Step 4:** To attach the mounting brackets to the double dresser and hutch you will need to line the brackets up (as shown on photo 1) and screw in place.
- Step 5:** Attach the anti-tip restraint as shown in the instructions. Use the instructions included in the anti-tip restraint package.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS: The natural warmth of wood is a lasting value. Character marks, checking and grain variations are part of the beauty of wood and, therefore, should not be a concern. To preserve your furniture, we suggest the following:

- Do not expose furniture to direct sunlight or extreme changes in temperature or moisture.
- Do not place the furniture near heating or air conditioning vents.
- Wipe up spills promptly.
- When cleaning your furniture, use non-toxic, non-abrasive furniture cleaner with soft, lint-free cloth. Dry thoroughly and then apply furniture polish. Always wipe the furniture in the direction of the wood grain.
- If refinishing, use non-toxic finish specified for children's products.

We recommend the furniture to be polished every six months. Over polishing can distort the natural finish of the product.

WARNING!

- ✓ Failure to follow these warnings and the assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death. Follow warnings on all products in a crib.
- ✓ Infants can suffocate on soft bedding. Never add a pillow or comforter. Never place additional padding under an infant.


✓ To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.

WARNING!

- ✓ Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier-cords. Do not suspend strings over a crib or attach strings to toys.
- ✓ To help prevent strangulation tighten all fasteners. A child can trap parts of the body

or clothing on loose fasteners.

- ✓ DO NOT place crib near window where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- ✓ When child is able to pull to a standing position, set mattress to lowest position and remove bumper pads, large toys and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.
- ✓ Stop using crib when child begins to climb out or reaches the height of 35 in. (89 cm).
- ✓ After raising side, make sure latches are secure (omit for stationary side cribs).
- ✓ DO NOT leave child in crib with side lowered. Be sure side is in raised and locked position whenever child is in crib (omit for stationary side cribs).
- ✓ Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, loose bolts or other fasteners, missing parts, or sharp edges before and after assembly and frequently during use. Securely tighten loose bolts and other fasteners. DO NOT use crib if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact Baby's Dream Furniture Inc., for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts.
- ✓ Read all instructions before assembling crib. Keep instructions for future use.
- ✓ Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers because they can cause suffocation.
- ✓ Infants can suffocate in gaps between crib sides and a mattress that is too small.
- ✓ If refinishing, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.

 **CAUTION ANY MATTRESS USED IN THIS CRIB MUST BE AT LEAST 27 1/4" X 51 5/8" WITH A THICKNESS NOT EXCEEDING 6" AND NOT UNDER A MINIMUM THICKNESS OF 4". INFANTS CAN SUFFOCATE IN GAPS BETWEEN CRIB SIDES AND MATTRESSES THAT ARE TOO SMALL.**

WARNING ENTRAPMENT/STRANGULATION HAZARD

- ✓ Infants have died in toddler beds from entrapment and strangulation.
- ✓ Failure to follow these warnings and the assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death.
- ✓ NEVER use bed with children under 15 months.
